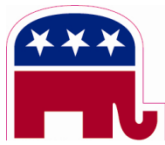

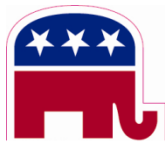

Thousands of Republicans from across the nation will be heading to the Big Easy for the 2011 Republican Leadership Conference and Reagan Centennial Celebration.

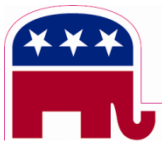
